


Communication – Signals and Calls





Signals are used for silent communication

- Communication with the players, coaches, and fans
 - Do not pitch
 - Play Ball
 - Time out, dead ball, foul ball
 - Safe
 - Current Count
 - Number of outs
 - Strike or Out
 - Fair Ball
 - Foul Tip
 - Infield Fly
- Communication with the fellow umpires on the field
 - Number of outs
 - Time Play
 - Infield Fly Rule is in effect





Communication – Signals and Calls



The Interference Call

- Associated to the offense
- Immediate 'dead' ball call

The Obstruction Call

- Associated to the defense
- This call is similar to interference except the ball may remain 'live'.

Fair/Foul

- In PHBA, Plate Umpire responsibility to make the Fair/Foul determination.
 - If the ball is fair, DO NOT SAY ANYTHING.

Catch / No Catch

Plate Umpire responsibility to make the Catch / No Catch Signal

The Foul Tip

Plate Umpire responsibility to make the Catch / No Catch Signal
